Criteria for Abstracts

• Topics must be relevant to metabolic dysregulation or obesity related cancer risk.

MeDOC Consortium Goals

- Understand the mechanisms of obesity-related metabolic dysregulation and cancer risk
- Characterize signal cross-talk between key biologic processes
- Develop common measures and methods to support collaborative projects and to advance the field
- Determine the utility of emerging approaches to identify targets for potential intervention
- Translate mouse model data to human studies
- Develop outreach efforts that can translate evidence into policies that mitigate health disparities
